MESSAGE FROM THE GVRVR MANAGERS:

I want to remind everyone of the current "Park COVID Policy". I have been hearing of people testing positive, but the office has not received any notifications from residents that they in fact tested positive. I need this info from you to know how to respond to situations. Obviously if two or three people test positive for Covid, we would monitor the situation but keep things as normal as possible. But, if I get 12 or 20 or more sick and testing positive for Covid, we have a problem and may need to alter what we are doing with our social activities.

The "<u>Park COVID Policy</u>" is based on guidance passed by the Pima County Board of Supervisors and the Arizona Department of Health Services.

Activities Committees with Management concurrence may set event specific guidelines. We want to maximize individual liberty, but at the same time, we expect everyone to exercise personal responsibility by following park and event specific guidelines.

PARK GUIDELINES.

- IF YOU ARE SICK OR FEEL ILL (Fever, Dry Cough, Headache, etc.), DO NOT USE ANY PARK FACILITY, even if you are vaccinated. Contact your health care provider for guidance.
- If you have COVID symptoms or have been exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid, stay home, away from people, and get tested. Follow guidance published in the flow chart from the *Arizona Department of Health Services*. - If you test positive: quarantine yourself, immediately <u>notify the park office</u> and seek medical attention. For further info on what to do if sick or testing positive for COVID, go to:

- IF YOU USE PARK FACILITIES, YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- Masks/face coverings are optional in the clubhouses, unless required by event specific guidance, and/or
 for example at a food event serving line. Masks are not required for outdoor activities such as the pools,
 spas, shuffleboard courts, etc.
