The grounds are beautiful, and the museum is excellent. It is a great example of old Spanish and Indian life. We will have a tour of the site beginning at 10A. The cost of admission to the park is \$10.00 or FREE with an America the Beautiful National Park Pass. Each pass admits four people so we will meet outside of the front door to use passes to admit others in the group who do not have a pass. Each person with a pass must have the pass as well as a photo ID.

GVRVR is fortunate to have an AED onsite in the clubhouse available for use in the event of a cardiac related health emergency. The AED is located on the wall outside of office's back door across from the card table area. The AED's purchase was funded by the Activity Committee.

In each of our park's newsletters, there is a list of these trained responders (completed Red Cross training in its proper use, including current CPR recommended procedures). We suggest you cut this list out and post it in your residence for quick access. We are very fortunate to have both the AED onsite and trained responders here in the park. Please familiarize yourself with who they are and who lives closest to your lot. Also please extend a sincere THANK YOU to these responders for their willingness to assist in the event of a medical emergency.

In the event of a cardiac related medical emergency, immediately call 911 to get the ambulance rolling.
